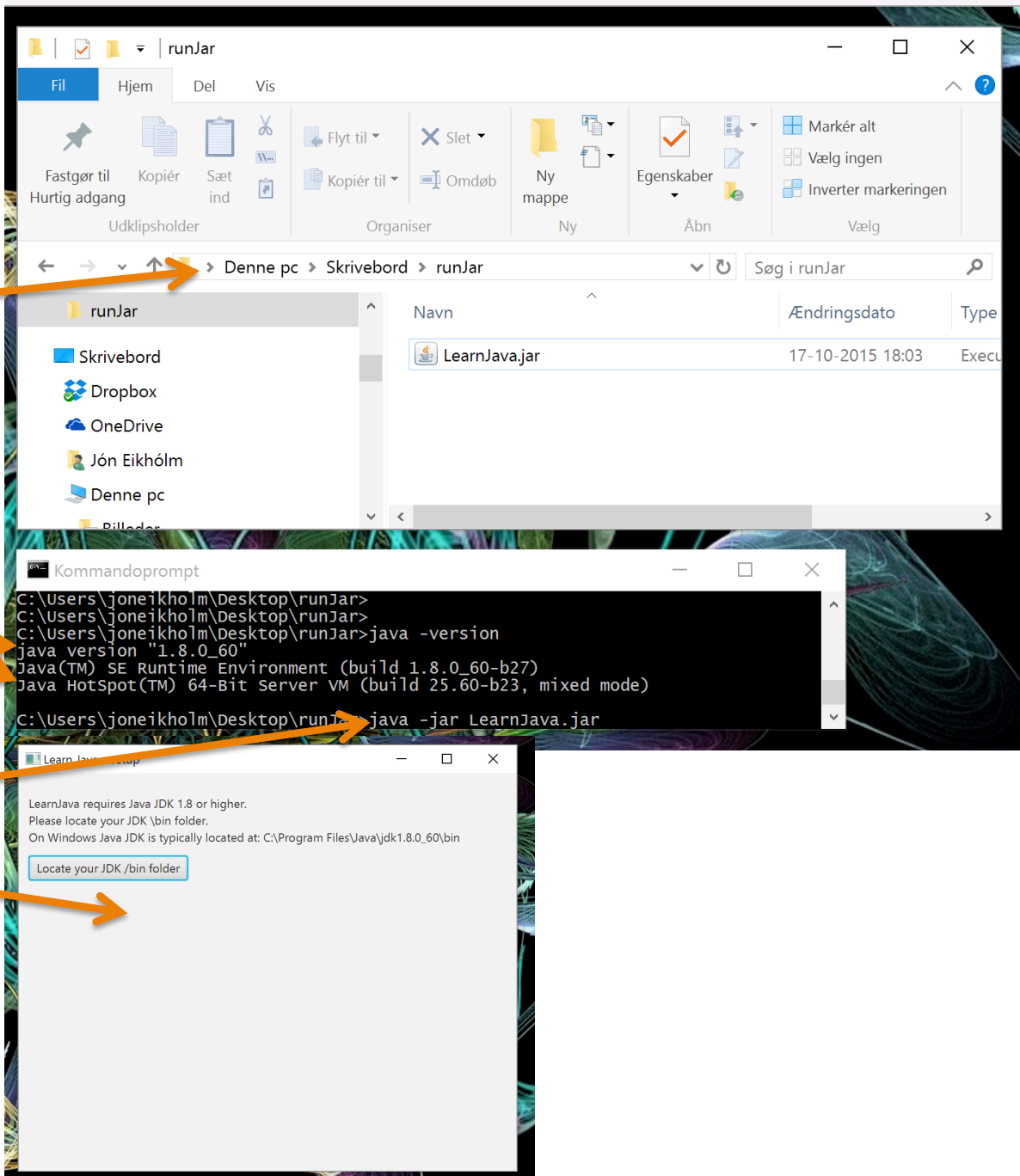


## To install LearnJava:

1. Download LearnJava.jar from <http://learnjava.joneikholm.dk/>
2. Place the file in a folder, where it may stay permanently. Ex "runJar"
3. Open the command prompt (CMD)
4. Type: `java -version`
5. If you don't see something similar to this, stop this guide and go to next page.
6. In the command prompt, navigate to the folder, where LearnJava.jar is located.
7. Now type this: `java -jar LearnJava.jar`
8. If this window launches, you should be OK.
9. Click the button
10. Locate your Java JDK\bin folder. For example like this: "C:\Program Files\Java\jdk1.8.0\_60\bin"
11. The Application should launch after this.



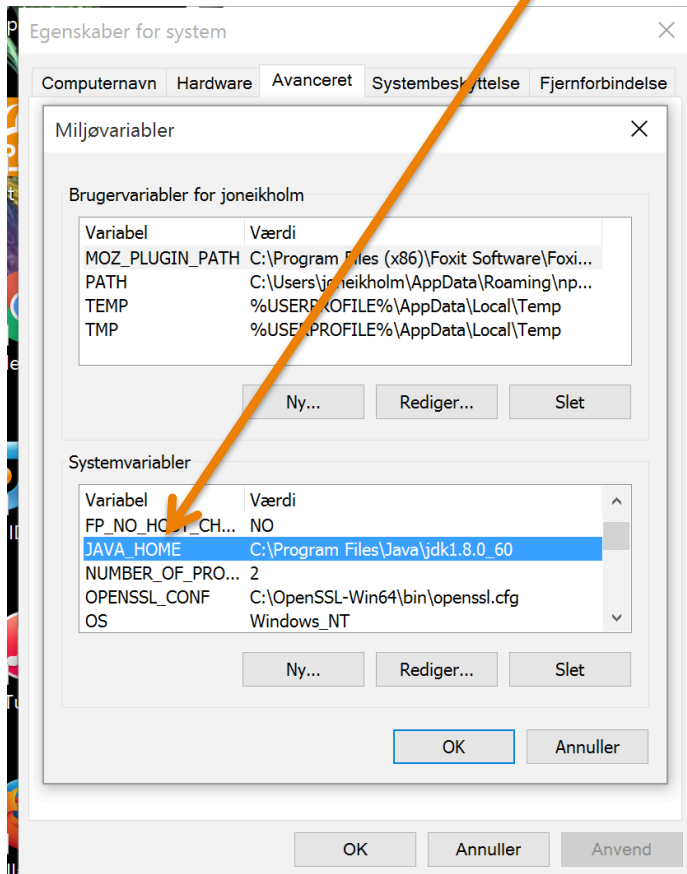
# Checking system variables in Windows

1. Locate System Variables by:

- a) right-click "This Computer" in Explorer
- b) click "Advanced System settings"
- c) click "Environment variables"

2. Check that JAVA\_HOME is located here, and points to:

"your path"\\Java\\jdk1.x.x:



3. Check that the Path variable has a path to Java JRE, like this: If it doesn't, you need to add a path to JRE.

- a) Click on the "Path" variable
  - b) Click "Edit"
  - c) Add the path to your JRE\\bin folder to the **end** of the string. Start with semicolon, if there is a path already.
- For example it could look like this:  
"... ;C:\\Program Files\\Java\\jdk1.8.0\_60\\jre\\bin"
